Dear generous donors,

I am writing you on behalf of the **Foundation for Water & Education, Cambodia** (FWEC), a non-political group that was established in 2012. FWEC has its roots in the Clean Water & Education Project (CWEP), a small initiative that I started in early 2010 with the support of Ms. Graciela Andrade (who donated the first well).

Each year **FWEC** continues to advance the cause of *Health and Education* by providing wells for clean water and bicycles for children to get to school. Through our *program of Clean Water*, we have provided over 280 wells and have seen many lives and activities changed for the better. (All donated wells and their recipient families - including photos, names/ages of all family members and village/commune - can be found through the supporter page of our website at: www.fwe-cambodia.org/our-supporter.php.)

It is our mission to continue to identify the poor communities and families (levels 1 and 2 in the government classification of the poverty) in the rural surrounds of Siem Reap, Cambodia, i.e. those who are in desperate need of clean water. In order to meet our mission and enable these poor people and their children to live a more self-sufficient and sustainable life, we rely on the generosity of individuals and businesses for support. Without the assistance of community-minded groups just like yours, we would not be able to help these families and their communities.



We would like to ask “you” for your support the FWEC in the amount of US\$3900 to improve the lives of 15 families and 20 children in a community of Krouch village in the poorest rural areas around Siem Reap. Our goal with these funds is to provide each family with a well (the pump is guaranteed for five years), and to purchase the bicycles for the children transfer to school. The wells would not only give the families clean water, but would also permit them to irrigate the seeds and grow their own vegetables in a self-sufficient manner. With clean water, your donation will greatly contribute towards the improved health of 15 families in a sustainable way. Your generosity, therefore, would make a significant difference to the lives of the poorest people in our community.

Bicycles (optional)

Many beneficiaries of our wells live in very rural areas, which mean that the children need to walk long distances to go to school. As part of the education programme of FWEC, we invest in these children by helping them get to school by supplying them with bicycles. (Information about bicycles donated so far can be found under the supporter page of our website at: www.fwe-cambodia.org/other-supporters.php)

Due to our assessment, there are 15 families needing help and 20 children would need 20 bicycles which the budget and the items costs are:

15 Wells (US\$200 x 15 families) = US\$3000

20 bicycles (\$45 x 20 children) = \$900

Should you feel that this amount is more than you can contribute, we ask you to consider funding the amount of your willing to donate.
